... just visit the Augsburg Puppet Theatre Museum “die Kiste”, right here you can have the chance to get a close look at busily working craftspeople, master craftsmen and women and other journeymen.

These wooden workers of the Augsburg Puppenkiste particularly symbolize the exciting connection between manual work and art.

But not only figures of the “Augsburger Puppenkiste” are represented within this special exhibition. Manually skilled guests: woodcarvers and bakers from the “Laubacher Figure Theatre”, travel all the way to Augsburg.

The “Figure Theatre Cologne”, provides the exhibition with a miller, taking care of grinding the corn. In addition, freshly cooked sausages, served directly from the hot cooking pot (!), are supplied by the butcher of the “Puppet Theatre in the Blue House”. Support is also coming from abroad: The National Museum Prague sends out “temporary workers” to the Augsburg Puppet Theatre Museum, such as shoemakers, tailors and a blacksmith.

In cooperation with the Swabian Chamber of Crafts, as well as various guilds and companies, the exhibition shows the tradition, modernity and diversity of skilled crafts.
